Eligibility Requirements			

• Be a person of Mexican, Puerto Rican, Cuban, Central or South American, or other Spanish culture or origin, regardless of race.

• Be an active member of a CalPac local UMC for a minimum of one year.

In order to apply for the UMC Latino Youth SAI Scholarship, applicants must satisfy the following criteria:

- Submit at least one letter of recommendation from the Pastor or church leader.
- Attending or will attend an accredited 2-year community college, 4 year college or university or vocational program in the next academic school year.
- Full-time enrollment (minimum 12 units per semester) in a regular degree program is required.
- Complete the SAI application process.

• A minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.5 in high school and/or college is preferred.

- Scholarship applicants do not need to be US citizens. Permanent residents or undocumented students will be considered. • Graduate and PhD candidates are not eligible for SAI scholarships.
- An individual may receive only one SAI scholarship.
